Ravenscroft Crystal Introduces New Amplifier Wine Glass Series

Ravenscroft Crystal has introduced a new handmade, lead-free wine glass collection called the Amplifier Tasting Collection. The four-glass line includes a Cabernet, Unoaked White, Mature Red Wine and a Barrique White glass, each designed to magnify and intensify aromas. The exaggerated shapes tend also to magnify faults such as excessive alcohol, Brettanomyces, or oxidation. The lead-free composition creates a very thin glass, but one that is less fragile and considerably lighter in weight than competitors **Riedel** and **Spiegelau**. The Amplifier series is similar in design to Riedel's Extreme collection.

Wholesale pricing of Ravenscroft Crystal is dependent on quantity purchased, with the Amplifier retail glass price \$15-\$20 per stem, and wholesale prices ranging from 40-50 percent discount of that. Ravenscroft also produces a full line-up of more traditionally-shaped, lead-free stemware.
